

The Project

Students will learn and sing carols in the native language, learn a short carol in English and in the partner school language. They will prepare Christmas cards and write Christmas wishes to the children of the partner school and add on TwinSpace. They will know traditions and celebrations from our own home country and learn about others. Children will realise that they are part of a wider community.

AIMS

- To promote cultural understanding and the sense of belonging to a wider culturally diverse community
- To learn English language.

HOW TO WORK

1. Geography/Tradition:

- To find the countries which participate in the project on the map.
- To make work sheets with several characteristics of the partner country, e.g., the flag, the language, etc.

Note: the work sheets will be easy to complete. For example; matching exercises, painting pictures, making puzzles of the flags, etc.

2. Our Christmas carol in the native language (movie or recording)

3. Our Christmas carol in English (movie or recording)

4. Our Christmas carol (not very difficult) in the partner school language - (movie or recording)

5. To prepare Christmas cards and write Christmas wishes (PDF, photos,...) by using cardboard, gold dust, cotton and other materials. We are going to use model cards for the children and let them use their own ideas and imagination as well.

6. To scan the cards and send them by e-mail.

7. To say goodbye

The result of the project will be the movies, recorded carols, photographs of our Christmas cards. The project results will be placed on TwinSpace and school website.
